Now in its 19th year, the Trento Festival of Economics is confirmed as a point of reference in the national and international economic and institutional landscape to address the major challenges of the present and explore possible future directions. May 23 through 26, the Festival will bring together a diverse range of participants from all over the world, including ministers, Nobel laureates, scientists, entrepreneurs and managers, offering an unprecedented opportunity for discussion. With the topic "Where are you going? The dilemmas of our time", the Festival invites us to explore the perspectives that will emerge in a context marked by serious geopolitical, climatic and demographic crises.
