The school coordinated by **Vittorio Morandi (CNR-IMM)** and [Lorenza Ferrario](#) (FBK) will offer training courses on the basic manufacturing and characterization processes, with attention to both planar and 3D devices and with a session dedicated to cleanroom characteristics and operations.
