Successful short training course on rapid prototyping in Rwanda in partnership with ACEIoT (African Center of Excellence in Internet of Things).



WAZIUP organized a short course on [IoT rapid application prototyping course](#) in Rwanda in cooperation with ACEIoT. The opening ceremony was led by ICT ministry of Rwanda and there

were presentations from the important actors like SmartAfrica initiative, Smart City Innovation, Rwanda Development Board and other international donors. The whole event was highly successful. The short course was held from April 23rd to 27th, 2018.

It was a 5 days training course where 40 students coming from 5 different countries in Africa with mixed backgrounds and to come up with ideas of social problems that could be solved using technology.



Students were asked to develop a prototype based on WAZIUP technologies and after 3 days they were able to develop 9 IoT initial prototypes and give a pitch of their social innovation. Certificates were awarded to students who successfully completed the course.
